Act of Congress	5/14/1898	This Act provides for an 80 rod shore space reserve between Claims (30 Stat 400). Amended and modified by Act of Congress, March 3, 1903 (32 Stat 1028) to provide locations on navigable waters and entries on unsurveyed Lands. Amended by Act of Congress, June 5, 1920 (41 Stat 1059) to provide modification of restriction on location of homestead entries. Amended by Act of Congress, August 3, 1955 (69 Stat 444), to provide for the abolition of the 80 rod reserved spaces between claims on shore waters in Alaska.
Executive Order	4/13/1899	This executive order amends EO of 10/20/1897 by placing part of Ft St Michael military reservation (which lies north of 64 Degrees Latitude) under control of this department for disposal under the Act of 7/5/1884. Ref EO 10/24/1900.
Executive Order	10/24/1900	This EO recommends that all lands included within the limits of the military reservation of Ft St Michael, Alaska, declared by EO of 10/20/1897, and reduced by EO of 4/13/1899, except the Island of St Michael and all other lands and islands lying within a radius of ten miles of the flag staff of the post of Ft. St. Michael, Alaska, be placed under the control of the Secretary of the Interior for disposition under the act of July 5, 1884. Ref EO 8014, 11/26/1938.
Act of Congress	3/3/1903	Amends and modifies Act of Congress 5/14/1898 to provide locations on navigable waters; entries on unsurveyed Lands.
Executive Order	11/3/1910	Withdraws from settlement, location, sale or entry, and reserved for Classification and in Aid of Legislation affecting the use of petroleum Lands. Revoked by PLO 5112 9/17/1971.
Executive Order 1324 1/2	3/28/1911	Withdraws from settlement, location, sale, or entry and reserved for Public Purpose pending legislation providing for the use of medicinal springs, to the extent of 160 acres surrounding each spring. Amended by EO 1883 1/24/1914 so that it does not apply to Lands Within the National Forest. Revoked by PLO 399 8/27/1947.
Executive Order 1883	1/24/1914	Amends EO 1324 1/2 3/28/1911 so that it does not apply to Lands Within National Forest.
Act of Congress	3/4/1915	Reserved to territory of Alaska Sections 16 and 36 in each township when surveyed, for support of common schools (38 Stat Repealed by Act of 7/7/1958 for those public Lands which were unsurveyed as of 1/3/1959, the date of admission into the Union (72 Stat 39)).

Executive Order 5327	4/15/1930	Withdraws temporarily public oil-shale deposits and lands from lease or other disposal and reserved for purposes of investigation, examination, and classification unless and until revoked by the President or the Congress. Amended and modified by PLO 5562 12/18/1975 to extent necessary to permit withdrawals under Sections 11(a) and 14(h) and elections under Sections 12 or 14 of ANCSA 12/18/1971. See AA 71028.
Executive Order 5389	7/7/1930	Withdraws every smallest legal subdivision of the public land surveys which is vacant, unappropriated, unreserved, public land and contains a hot spring, or a spring which possess curative properties, and all land within 1/4 mile of every such spring located on unsurveyed public land. Amended by PLO 399 8/20/1947.
Executive Order 8014	11/26/1938	Places all tracts of land withdrawn for military purposes at the Circle, Hot Springs, Fort St. Michael and Iditarod Military Reservations, Alaska, under the control of the Secretary of the Interior for disposal as provided in the Act of 7/5/1884. Revokes EOs of 10/20/1897, 5/4/1908, 9/30/1908, 6/6/1914, and 12/16/1919 in so far as they affect the tracts of land described above. Ref PLO 2464 8/14/1961.
Executive Order 9145	4/23/1942	Withdraws a strip of land 200' wide on the Palmer-Richardson Highway for 145 miles from 42.8 in Section 36, NE4, 20N 5E SM, extending to Section 19, SE4, 4N 1W CRM. Revoked by PLO 601 8/10/1949.
Public Land Order 12	7/20/1942	Withdraws a strip of land 40 miles wide along general route of proposed highway from east of Richardson Highway. Reduced by PLO 270 4/5/1945.

Public Land Order 270	4/5/1945	Reduces withdrawal made by PLO 12 7/20/1942 from 40 miles to 10 miles wide.
Executive Order 9613	9/13/1945	Subject to valid existing rights, all public lands within the State which contains deposits of radio-active mineral substances, and all deposits of such substances are hereby withdrawn from sale and all other forms of disposal under public land laws, including the mining laws, and reserved for use of the U.S. This EO also applies to land acquired by and in process of acquisition by the U.S. Revoked by EO 9701 3/4/1946, provided that those lands containing fissionable materials remain reserved. Revoked by Act of Congress 8/13/1954 and Public Law 585 (68 Stat 708). Reservations of fissionable materials inserted into patents were released, remised, and quitclaimed to the appropriate landowner on August 19, 1958, by Public Law 85-681
Executive Order 9701	3/4/1946	Revokes EO 9613 9/13/1945 providing that those lands containing fissionable materials remain reserved.
Public Land Order 386	7/31/1947	Reduces withdrawal of public lands along Alaska Highway and opens released lands to settlement and to other forms of appropriation. Partially revoked by PLO 601 8/10/1949. Partially revoked PLO 1613 4/9/1958.
Public Land Order 399	8/27/1947	Revokes EO 1324 1/2 3/28/1911, Amends EO 5389 7/7/1930 to delete the words "Exclusion of Alaska", EO 5389 as herein amended shall not apply to lands within the National Forest.
Public Land Order 601	8/10/1949	Revokes EO 9145 4/23/1942, Part Rev PLO 386 7/31/1947, Rev PLO 412 9/28/1947; Reserves public lands for highway purposes, subject to valid existing rights. Amended by PLO 757 10/16/1951 and subject to existing surveys and withdrawals for other than highway purposes. Revoked by PLO 1613 4/9/1958.
Public Land Order 614	10/19/1949	Amends PLO 399 8/27/1947 which amended EO 5389 7/7/1930 so that the amendment now reads "shall not affect lands in national Forest, nor shall lands now outside of, or hereafter eliminated from, National Forest be subject to the provisions of such order by reason of their proximity to any such springs in a National Forest". Amended and modified by PLO 5563 12/18/1975 to extend necessary to permit withdrawals under Sec 11(a) (3) and 14(h) and selections under Sections 12 or 14(h) of ANCSA 12/18/1971.

Easements including but not limited to ditches and canals, railroads, telegraph and telephone lines, and rights-of-way existing at time of conveyance. The right to create easements in the future. This authority may be invoked for all withdrawals except: (1) Powersite reserves and powersite classifications; (2) land within the boundary of any national forest; and (3) areas withdrawn by Act of Congress, including but not limited to conservation system units and the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska.
